DRAFT Meadow Lane Recreation Ground survey results

A survey-monkey online survey was conducted in November 2021 of local residents' and Rec users' views on how they felt about the Rec now and what improvements if any they might like to see. 4 of the 10 questions invited open answers, the rest were multiple choice. The survey was advertised via leafleting the vast majority of Iffley Fields houses, through the IFRA website and Facebook pages, through neighbouring residents' associations, and through posters round the Rec. 157 responses were received.

Summary of Results:

The openness and the multiple and informal uses of the Rec are widely valued, and any changes should not interfere with this. Given this, there is support for more benches, better planting, a few additional sports facilities, and better maintenance of the area.

Thank you to all respondents for taking the time to give your views and suggestions. They were many and varied, and will help with future planning including when to do nothing. A full copy of responses has been retained.

Results in detail:

Q1. What do you particularly like or dislike about the Rec now?

This was an open question to which 131 respondents replied.

<u>Likes</u>: By far the commonest response in the whole survey and across all open questions was that the Rec is liked for being a wide open space, very flexible, informal and multi-use, not too prescriptive or cluttered, and a good community asset, and that these characteristics should be retained.

16 people mentioned that they would prefer it kept exactly as it is - no changes.

Dislikes: a wide variety of points were raised. Main ones were:

19 respondents find it too barren / open / boring / lack of landscaping

- 14 mentioned dog problems (mainly unpicked up dog poo, also dogs off leads).
- 14 mentioned anti-social behaviour (drugs / noise / lurkers/ feels unsafe)
- 10 lack of maintenance (around goal posts, uneven ground)
- 8 litter
- 7 seating problems (not enough of it, not liking the rotting logs)
- 8 lack of shade to sit under and/or by Meadow Lane.
- 5 dangers from traffic on Meadow Lane (too fast, no protection from it)

Q4 Are there other ways we could improve the Rec?

111 responses

16 respondents commented in one or more open questions that they wanted no changes

28 didn't select either benches, planting or more sports facilities.

Other suggestions: more litter bins (6), picnic tables/area (4), cafe or food/coffee vans (6), better lighting (3),bike locking station (3), nature/bird boxes (3). Sports requests see under sports questions.

And – improving features disliked, such as lack of maintenance.

Questions 5 and 6 referred to 2 suggested planting layouts for 6 trees for which there is grant money for the Council to plant.
